**TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
ORDER AND ORDER SETTING
HEARING ON MOTION FOR
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**



1 After considering plaintiff CMKM Diamonds, Inc.'s application for a Temporary
2 Restraining Order against Defendants Urban Casavant, The UAJC 2005 Irrevocable Trust,
3 Mike Williams, DeShawn L. Wayne, Brian Dvorak, James Kinney, Ginger Gutierrez, P.A.
4 Holdings, Inc., and Bucko LLC, as well as the pleadings and affidavits, the Court finds as
5 follows:

- 6 a. Absent a temporary restraining order, plaintiff will suffer immediate and
7 irreparable injury, loss, or damage as assets and records that appear to belong
8 to the corporation may be wasted or transferred by the defendants.
- 9 b. This injury is irreparable because the corporation may become insolvent
10 through the acts of defendants and any eventual legal remedy may be
11 ineffective in the event that the assets at issue are not available for recovery.
- 12 c. This ex parte order is granted without notice to Defendants because prior
13 actions of defendants suggest assets may be wasted or records lost and
14 destroyed if notice is given to the parties before Court intervention.

15
16 **ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

17 1. Defendants named above and their officers, agents, servants, employees,
18 attorneys, and all persons acting in concert with them be restrained from hiding, altering, or
19 destroying any records belonging or relating to CMKM Diamonds, Inc.

20 2. Defendants named above and their officers, agents, servants, employees,
21 attorneys, and all persons acting in concert with them are further restrained from selling,
22 trading, encumbering or transferring the following property until further order of this
23 Court:

24 i. The following real property:

- 25 1. 90 Innisbrook Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada
26 2. 30 Princeville Lane, Las Vegas, Nevada
27 3. 7146 Mission Hills, Las Vegas, Nevada
28 4. Durango Trails, Bldg. T, Las Vegas, Nevada

- 1 ii. Any funds or assets held in any bank, brokerage, or financial account
- 2 in the name of the UAJC 2005 Irrevocable Trust, including the
- 3 brokerage account held with Citigroup/Smith Barney, Acct. No. 647-
- 4 33547-17 303.
- 5 iii. Any property or assets held by Four Vegas Properties, including the
- 6 proceeds of settlement from the case entitled *Philip Smith v. Keith*
- 7 *McAllister, et al.*, Clark County District Court, Case No. A510773.
- 8 iv. The proceeds from the loan made to CSII in the amount of
- 9 \$2,250,000 or the stock that was purchased with these funds or any
- 10 derivative income stream from this investment.
- 11 v. The proceeds from the loan made to Crystallix in the amount of
- 12 \$3,000,000 or the stock that was purchased with these funds or any
- 13 derivative income stream from this investment.
- 14 vi. The proceeds from the loan made to Mobile Wireless Security in the
- 15 amount of \$1,000,000 or the stock that was purchased with these
- 16 funds or any derivative income stream from this investment.
- 17 vii. The funds repayable CMKM for loans made to Golden Arch
- 18 Resources in four separate checks totaling \$539,992.11 during
- 19 January of 2005.

20 3. A hearing to determine whether a preliminary injunction shall be issued in this
21 matter will take place on May 15, 2007 at 1:30 P.M. in this
22 department. Plaintiff shall file and serve a motion requesting the preliminary injunction on
23 or before May 3, 2007, 2007, and defendants shall file and serve any
24 opposition to the motion on or before NA, 2007. Any reply in
25 support of the motion shall be filed by plaintiff on or before NA, 2007.


26 4. This order shall not be effective until a bond in the amount of \$10,000⁰⁰ is
27 posted by plaintiff as security for the payment of such costs and damages as may be

2 restrained.
